Invest in Education is a campaign to support the passage of legislation that will boost investment in New York's public and nonpublic schools through an Education Investment Tax Credit.

New York has the opportunity to join more than a dozen other states with a smart and proven way to encourage investment in schools – helping children, parents and teachers – without asking homeowners to pay a nickel more in local property taxes. Bi-partisan Education Investment Tax Credit legislation was passed twice by the New York State Senate, most recently by a 55-to-4 margin. The State Assembly also has proposed – but has not yet passed – very similar legislation, which has approximately two-thirds of the Assemblymembers as co-sponsors.

The Education Investment Tax Credit legislation (A.1826-C & S.4099-A) is supported by a coalition of community, labor and religious groups listed below.
